In February 2024, a small group of staff members with film degrees decided to try teaching what they learned in college to library customers for free.

Over time, the program evolved from teaching screenwriting to reading scripts of famous films and watching the corresponding scenes to demonstrate how a script can transform from page to screen. Eventually, enough people were bringing in their own work that it became a place for writers of all experience levels to come and get feedback from their peers.
